

MANAGER TIDBITS - CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION INSURANCE

As many of you are aware, Toscana has had a fair amount of water loss issues over

the last few years. As a result, our insurance premium and deductibles that took affect on August 25, 2014 and are in place until August 25, 2015, have increased dramatically. This is primarily due to the fact that the amount of claims that have been paid out is much higher than the amount the Association has paid in premiums.

deductibles have increased from \$5,000.00 per occurrence to \$15,000.00 per occurrence. does this mean to you as a homeowner?

As a unit owner, you are responsible for insuring the contents of your unit and your personal liability. It is recommended that you include

enough Building Additions and Alterations coverage to replace anything that has been upgraded (i.e. cabinets, flooring, etc.). We also recommend that your unit owner policy insure additional living expenses, loss assessment and any gaps in coverage. Your agent should know and understand that you will be responsible for the \$15,000.00 deductible if a loss results from an area within your responsibility.

Be sure and contact your personal insurance agent to make sure that you are adequately covered and your coverage coincides with the Association's insurance. Report all claims immediately to the Community Association Manager.

We cannot stress to owners enough the importance of following the rules set forth with regards to maintaining your unit. All of your water supply lines should be changed out to steal braided hoses and inspected by a plumber on an annual basis thereafter. Also it is a good rule of thumb to not start a load of laundry or the dishwasher before leaving your unit for the day; please do these things while you are home in case an issue should arise. If you are in need of a qualified plumber or contractor for other maintenance items please refer to the VIP Program where many vendors offer special rates for Toscana Residents. was previously available. Once you create a user profile you will have access to everything you would expect. Some of the great new features include:

- The ability to see the events calendar and RSVP directly through the site! You can submit your name, number of guests and RSVP electronically with the click of a button. However, please note financial obligations will still need to be handled in person with Christina.
- · Access to community documents, recent Board of Directors meeting minutes, and electronic versions of the Newsletter. Whether you want to keep up on the recent board decisions, read through the CC&R's or download a PDF of a recent newsletter they are all available and more!
- See community announcements about upcoming projects. With a dedicated announcements section you will always be up to date with community projects and the goings on around Toscana. If you have a question? Go ahead and fill out an electronic form and send it off to your staff member of choice for a quick response.
- Have a parking stall to rent out? How about a coffee table to sell? In our new classifieds section you can list items for up to two weeks!

The above features are just a taste of what ToscanaLiving. net has to offer. We encourage everyone to take full advantage of the new features and give us feedback on any other documents or information that might be helpful.

On a similar note... If you aren't receiving email blasts I would strongly encourage you to contact Christina or myself to register your email. Why do we want your email address and how do we utilize our email provider to contact you?

- Weekly Email Blasts These include announcements from your Community Association Management, promotion for the signature events scheduled in the coming weeks and local events in the Desert Ridge Area.
- Project Information These include any specific information about current or upcoming projects with which we need your assistance. A recent example would be the notices concerning the asphalt resurfacing and restricted parking. These will be infrequent but will always contain important information.
- Emergency Information These will include any building specific information. Many of you received an email blast related to the gas being shut off in Building 1 - whether you live in Building 1 or not. Our new provider allows us to assign contacts by building and email notices to only the affected buildings in case of a similar issue or problem (water heater fails, front door being repaired or retrofitted, etc.). These will also be intermittent but contain valuable information.






MOVIE REVIEW — BOYHOOD: GROUND-BREAKING FILM IS MASTERFUL

As overseeding approaches, the central focus for this event comes down to one word: humidity.

Often people have a date in mind when overseeding of the turf areas should take place. This can range from early September to late October; however, humidity and rain fall play the central role in determining when that process takes place. Normally, operations to reduce water to the turf begin in September. Note, the key word is to "reduce water", not shut it off. Some companies to this day shut water off to the turf to ease the result of scalping; however, the short-term gain comes at the cost of a marginalized soil profile as that ground goes without water for multiple weeks if not longer. Reducing water to the Bermuda by 50% stresses the Bermuda and enables a smoother process of scalping as turf is reduced by a third weekly. When overseeding, it is critical to ensure

seeds are touching the ground and not caught in the Bermuda as those seeds will not germinate. A preference is to apply Perennial POA Free Rye seed at a heavier rate such as 15-lbs per 1,000 square feet of turf because of two benefits:

- 1. More densely applied Rye seed facilitates transition out of the grass in the Spring given how much competition there is to establish. Rye grass is consequently weaker overall due to the quantity of seed pods.
- 2. A more dense stand of turf assists in preventing weed growth given weeds need to have open spaces and sunlight to establish. With Rye grass applied at heavier rates, less sunlight and fewer open spaces exist for weeds to establish. As the Rye grass begins to germinate it will generally take 2-3 weeks prior to mowing; however, the

multiple run times after applying seed is critical so it does not wash away or become overly saturated. The multiple run-times come in the form of irrigation taking place 4-5 times a day, if not more for 2 minutes or so...enough to keep the seed moist, but not wet. It should not be forgotten that the Rye grass has in most cases a 30-day supply of fertilizer until a supplemental application can be performed allowing the rye grass to take up needed nutrients prior to the cold of winter setting in.

This process illustrates there are components to overseeding as there are reasons for each of the activities. It is important to be thorough and detailed because the moments of preparation and planning result in a quality stand of turf that will last through the winter months and early spring.
